

Jesuit Philelectic Society Safety Contract
STUDENTS: Please read, sign, and return.

As a member of the Jesuit High School Philelectic Society, you will be exposed to a working theatrical environment and there are certain dangers that are inherent to that environment. The theater becomes a “lab” in which you will learn proper use of tools and equipment used for scenic painting, set construction, creation of properties and costumes, and set up of lighting and sound equipment. The activities can be fun as well as informative and educational. To promote safety and to reduce the chance of accidents, rules are outlined below for students who work on in the Jesuit Auditorium. Scenic preparation and work crews take place ahead of each production or event in the theater. You must return this document to be filed in the Philelectic Society Office.

1. Students must follow the specific instructions of the faculty/staff supervisor.
2. Horseplay and practical jokes will not be tolerated.
3. Eating and drinking in the theater is limited to the side lobby ONLY.
4. Students should perform no unauthorized activities.
5. Students should never be in the Auditorium without adult supervision.
6. Goggles, coveralls, gloves, and other safety equipment must be used.
7. Nothing should be removed from the theater without permission.
8. Ladders must be footed and may not be moved by an individual alone.
9. No student may enter the tech booth, go on the catwalk, or climb a ladder without express permission of the faculty/staff supervisor and this signed released form on file.
10. All injuries, no matter how minor, must be reported.
11. Students must know the location of safety devices.
12. All work surfaces, tools and equipment must be cleaned and properly stored at the end of work time.

In summary, follow all instructions given by supervising faculty carefully
Protect eyes, hands, and body during the activity. Know the locations of safety equipment.
Above all, conduct yourself in a safe and responsible manner at all times in the Jesuit Auditorium.
